- 2. Widget List


3. Working with Chart

Let's take a look at the Default page and Widget.


Display the Sector Info and Stock Idea widgets on the right panels, and the Live Alerts and Stocks Listing widgets on the left panels.




2.1 STOCK LISTINGS

The user can click on any stock name to open a chart.


- 1. Click on this icon to show the dropdown list of all available markets.

- 3. Click on this icon to show the dropdown list which enables the selection in alphabet A to Z and 0 to 9 to find a stock.

Let's take a look at the Stock Info


The user is able to view the stock information of any counter.



2.3 LIVE ALERTS


Let's take a look at the Announcements

User can set certain constraints in the settings window to filter the alerts.


- **1.** Insert the minimum and maximum price constraints, volume and period, ADR, relative strength and %P, the alerts will be reflected accordingly.

Let's take a look at the Fear and Greed Index feature.


Displays the Fear and Greed index to reflect the market sentiment for the selected market

Let's take a look at the Notes.


Able to display the created notes on the chart based on the selected counter or market.

Let's take a look at the Sector Information feature.


Sector Info Panel provides the company Sector, Industry, Market Capital, Shares Outstanding and other information at a glance. Below is the example shown in HKSE.

The user is able to view top movers from the selected market. The value will be highlighted and update to the latest price.




2.9 STOCK IDEA


Let's take a look at the Stock Idea feature.

Allows users to screen stocks based from their selected metrics.

- 1. Click on the market icon, it will show list of market and user can select.
- 2. Click on the template drop down menu, it will show available template that user can select, edit and save. Each template will contain the user's saved metrics and filters that they can reuse anytime by simply selecting.
- 3. Click on the column setup drop down menu, it will show list of metrics and user can select by clicking the checkbox and the chosen metric will be added as a new column.
- 4. Click on the period drop down menu, users can select a period which will determine the change in price and volume values based time frame.
- 5. Click on the categories drop down menu, it will show list of stock categories that users can choose from. Each stock categories will generate the list of stocks that follow the metrics required by the category.




6. Click on the screener filters will shows the editable filters that user can edit based on their own preference. User will need to check the checkbox to enable the filter and input their desired values. Do take note that stocks generated by the screener is **calculated using End of day data**.

Let's take a look at the Recently Viewed.


The user is able to view the recently viewed counter



3.WORKING WITH CHART


3.1 Dark Theme

Turn on the dark theme to switch to dark mode.




3.2 Search Stock

Type the name or code of the stock in the search box to search, click on the stock name and the chart will appear.




3.3 Changing the chart time frames

You are able to view intraday (tick, 1 min, 5 min, 10 min, 15 min, 30 min, hourly), daily+, daily, weekly+, weekly, monthly+ and monthly chart.



3.4 Using Different Chart Types

You are able to view the plotted chart 5 different ways by clicking on Candlestick, Bar Chart, Close Price Line, Heikin Ashi or Performance Chart button on top of the chart:



3.5 Toggle News and Notes On Chart


You are able to turn on and off icons for notes, and adjustments on the chart.



3.6 Indicator and Templates

- 1. Click on the 'Template' title to show the indicator list.
- 2. User can check or uncheck the checkbox for each indicator to show or hide it in the chart.
- 3. Click on the pencil icon to rename template
- 4. Click on the setting button to configure the indicator setting.
- 5. Click on the 'Reset Parameters' button to reset all the indicators back to default setting.

Glossary of Indicators:



3.6.1 Improvements on the indicator Feature

- 1. Indicator Legend changes

 Quick toggle for Indicator on chart without accessing to Indicators List panel
- 2. Hide/show the specific indicator
- 3. Access to indicator parameters easily for any changes
- 4. Remove indicator from chart with a click
- 5. Expand to full view on the indicator
- 6. Remove indicator from chart with a click




3.7 Other widget on chart

- 1. Zoom In
- 2. Zoom Out
- 3. Scroll Left
- 4. Scroll Right
- 5. Reset Chart

3.8 Adjustments

Corporate actions such as Bonus issue, Dividend, Right issue and Stock split will be shown as a bell on chart. You can enable or disable any corporate action adjustment on your chart here.



3.9 Drawing Tools

Click on the drawing icon to show or hide the drawing tools on the left panel.



3.9.1 Zooming in and out of the chart

Click on the point cursor and drag left or right to zoom in or out of the chart.



3.9.2 View Data Labels

Click on the data label button to make the data label constantly visible.



3.9.3 Drawing Lines

To make analysis easier, you can draw vertical line, horizontal line, gain loss ruler line, draw line, parallel line, trend line, regression line, projection line, and line with arrow head in the chart.



3.9.4 Rectangle and Translucent Oval

You can draw rectangle and translucent oval in the chart.



3.9.5 Adding Comments

Adding comments to a chart can help you to record and recall what you have observed. Besides, it will be good too if you are sharing the chart with someone else later and you would like to provide your own insights and comments in it.



3.9.6 Cyclic lines

You can draw cyclic lines on the chart.



3.9.7 Fibonacci Drawing tools

 ${f N}$ o charting tool would be complete without the Fibonacci series.



3.9.8 Change Drawing Color

You can change the color setting for all of the chart elements. To change the color, click on color button before you insert or add the chart elements. You can also select any drawing on the chart, and change the color using the below.




3.9.9 Redo or Undo actions and Removing chart elements

There are two solutions if you have mistakenly edited the annotations on the chart or if you want to remove it.




3.10 Hide Drawing or Indicator

Able to hide indicators, hide drawings, hide all (drawings and indicators) and show all (drawings and indicator).



3.11 Palm


Charts are plotted over a period of time. You can navigate and drag the chart using palm.



3.12 Adjust Display Period of Chart


You are given the flexibility to choose between the following viewing duration for the chart:

- 1 year




3.13 Dividend

Able to show All, Upcoming, Today and Historical dividend according to the market.




3.14 <u>Layout</u>

User can select their preferred layout, which consists of chart layouts and panel layouts. For the panel layout, there are 15 options available, and users can view up to 4 panels at the same time. For the chart layout, there are 4 different view types.



3.15 Other Features

Other features include snapshot, resetting the Y-axis scale in charts, refreshing the chart, accessing the user guide, and checking connection status.
